Presidents Elect. As enacted at the Rotary Council of Legislation, RI requires attendance at PETS as stated: "if the president-elect does not attend the Presidents Elect Training Seminar and the District Assembly, and has not been excused by the District Governor elect or, if so excused, does not send a designated club representative to such meetings, the president elect shall not be able to serve as club president. In such an event, the current president shall continue to serve the club as club president until a successor who has attended a President Elect Training Seminar and District Assembly or training deemed sufficient by the District Governor elect has been duly elected."

Besides it being mandatory for presidents elect, the training prepares incoming club presidents to lead their clubs by placing emphasis on their roles, expectations and direction from the District Governor to include the RI Theme for the upcoming year. The separate Leadership training provides an opportunity for District and Club leaders to participate in group discussions with outstanding leaders from Rotary

President Elect Nominee. If President Elect Nominees (PEN) are able to attend, it is highly recommended. The job of Club President is the most important in Rotary and any head start on the job requirements will be of benefit during your year. We have a separate track for PEN's that will provide the information you will need.
